Remember that if something happens in the past, we change the way we spell the verb. Often we add the suffix 'ed.'

For the next 2 days we would like you to practise spelling some past tense verbs. Look at the pattern with the words and remember the rules.

Just add -ed	Take away the e and add -ed	Double the consonant and add -ed
Walk - walked	Dance - danced	Stop - stopped
Jump - jumped	Race - raced	Grab - grabbed
Call - called	Like - liked	Hug - hugged

Can you think of any more verbs that would follow each of these patterns?
