

LO: To revise and practise the spelling of words ending in 'ible' and 'able'.

Remember the rule:

- able is **usually** used when a complete root word can be heard before it. e.g. dependable
- ible is **usually** used when a complete root word cannot be heard before it. e.g. visible

Read the text. Can you find any 'ible' or 'able' words?

Highlight or underline the 'ible' words in one colour and the 'able' words in another.
