

Maths Day 1 – 2 times table

Over the next 2 days we would like you to work on remembering your two times table. Let's start with some counting in twos. You can use this video here...

Find some objects at home that you can practise counting in twos with (beads, pasta, lego, etc.) Sometimes it helps to group them into twos so you can count them.

When you've practised your counting, see if you can write out your 2 times table.

$$0 \times 2 = 0$$

$$1 \times 2 = 2$$

And so on...

Then see if you can answer these number sentences...

$$12 = \square \times 2$$

$$2 \times \square = 22$$

$$2 \times \square = 16$$

$$4 = \square \times 2$$

$$2 \times \square = 18$$

$$2 \times \square = 20$$
