Year 1	<p>Themes and contexts: Greetings and introductions Colours Saying how we are Numbers 1-5 Stories and songs in French</p> <p>Key skills: To listen to and follow a story in French To engage in language-learning and enjoy singing and speaking in the target language Understanding and responding to questions To understand that there are different languages spoken in the world</p>
Year 2	<p>Themes and contexts: Greetings and introductions Days of the week Numbers 1-10 My age The weather Colours Parts of the body Animals</p> <p>Key skills: To engage in language-learning and enjoy singing and speaking in the target language To speak in a short exchange: say two things about yourself, responding to common and familiar questions Speaking independently and showing curiosity To begin to recognise written words such as colours, days and numbers To participate in telling stories and singing songs in French, filling in words that they know To understand that there are different languages spoken in the world</p>
Year 3	<p>Themes and contexts: Greetings, colours, numbers, days of the week My body The weather Explore colours and feelings through the story 'Mixed' Pets Foods, days and quantities through the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' Numbers 1-20</p> <p>Key skills: To begin to write first words in French and adapt short sentences to write about themselves To identify common words when reading and listening a story To present ideas when speaking and take part in a short role-play To develop an understanding of the wider world and languages different to our own</p>

Year 4	<p>Themes and contexts: Parts of the body; monster topic Foods and Halloween Numbers, months, dates and birthdays The weather Describing physical appearance Numbers 1-31</p> <p>Key skills: To write longer sentences; adapting sentences by replacing words to present their own ideas To write to describe To read full sentences and understand main points and vocabulary To listen for details in a description To speak with clear pronunciation To develop understanding of cultures and languages different to our own</p>
Year 5	<p>Themes and contexts: Expressing likes and dislikes Looking up new nouns Bilingual dictionary skills Pets and family Describing ourselves and others Speaking role-play 'All about me'</p> <p>Key skills: To speak and write in full sentences to express points of view To understand nouns and gender in French To be proficient in looking up nouns in a bilingual dictionary To speak without prompts in a role-play setting To write to describe To identify similarities and differences between languages</p>
Year 6	<p>Themes and contexts: At school; school in France Likes and dislikes Describing ourselves and others Mini-books – all about me Numbers 1-60 French café My room</p> <p>Key skills: To speak more spontaneously to express an opinion To write a short paragraph, adapting commonly used phrases To write independently; to spell common words and phrases accurately To identify details when reading and listening, showing a development of comprehension skills To speak without prompts in a role-play setting Appreciate and respect cultural diversity and present information about a culture different to my own</p>
